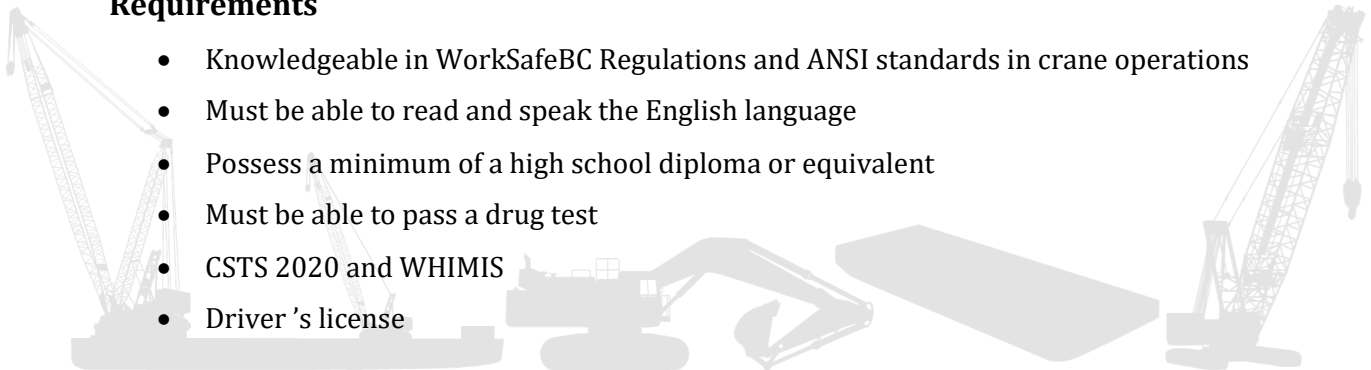
Deck Engineer

Essential Job Functions

- Working on a barge assisting dredging operations
- Responsible for repairs and maintains deck machinery
- Operates winches for anchors, spuds, and other equipment
- Works and assists others on barge to maintain dredging production
- Aligns, levels, and anchors cranes and equipment
- Completes daily inspections of all deck equipment and machinery
- Lubricate or apply adhesives or other materials to machines, machine parts, or other equipment, according to specified procedures.
- Install, replace, or change machine parts and attachments, according to product specifications.
- Dismantle machines and remove parts for repair, using hand tools, chain falls, jacks, cranes, or hoists.
- Clean machines and machine parts, using cleaning solvents, cloths, air guns, hoses, vacuums, or other equipment.
- Remove hardened material from machines or machine parts, using abrasives, power and hand tools, jackhammers, sledgehammers, or other equipment.
- Replace, empty, or replenish machine and equipment containers such as gas tanks or boxes.
- Fuel machines and assist in all general duties

Requirements

- Knowledgeable in WorkSafeBC Regulations and ANSI standards in crane operations
- Must be able to read and speak the English language
- Possess a minimum of a high school diploma or equivalent
- Must be able to pass a drug test
- CSTS 2020 and WHIMIS
- Driver's license



Physical Requirements

- Will be required to wear appropriate PPE equipment.
- Occasionally be exposed to extreme temperatures, fumes, or airborne particles.
- Noise level in the workplace is moderate.
- Work will frequently require individuals to push, pull, bend, or stand for long periods of time, and climb ladders that have capacity limits of 300 lbs.
- Must be able to lift or carry miscellaneous equipment, supplies and parts up to 50 lbs. unassisted
